We first became acquainted with these two guys, Azat and Zhenya, when Eric & his colleague, Sergei, were speaking at a pastor's conference in a province called Sumi. Promoting vision and strategy for church planting took Eric and Sergei to many provinces of Ukraine. After the conference, Azat spoke to us about planting a church in a regional center of this province. In January, he and his friend, Zhenya, moved to the target area of the church plant and began their training. Today, they have a small group that is meeting regularly.

Rustam and Sergei. Rustam is the director of the church planter training program. Sergei is the senior presbyter in charge of home missions for the largest evangelical entity in all of Ukraine. Together with Eric, they form a team that recruits, trains, and mentors church planting teams throughout Ukraine.
